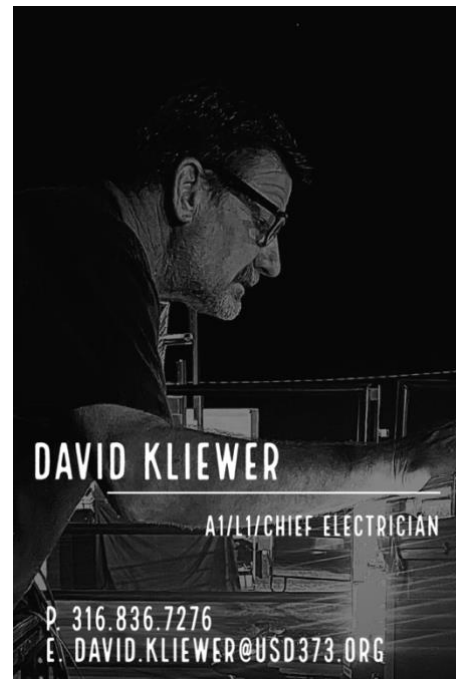

4) FAQ

What is Schudio Sound's coverage area? Schudio Sound has and will travel anywhere in the Continental United States.

What is the largest audience you've had to cover? Schudio Sound's largest event audience was roughly 6000 people, but can cover as many as 10,000 spectators.

How much does Schudio Sound charge to provide production? Schudio Sound bids each and every event on a "case-by-case" basis, as there are multiple variables to consider when determining accurate pricing.

Can Schudio Sound get (blank) for this event? Schudio Sound has developed countless relationships with industry professionals, backline providers, and other production companies over the years. If we don't have it, we can get it.

Can Schudio Sound record live concerts? Yes. Schudio Sound can record up to 48 tracks simultaneously into Pro Tools upon request. These recorded tracks can also be mixed and mastered, or released to the buyer as raw, unaltered stems.

Is your haze fluid oil based? No. We use only water-based haze and quick dissipating fluid.

How long does it take you to setup? This is completely dependent on the event and production requests/requirements, but on average, Schudio Sound can be show-ready in 4 hours time.

Do you provide drive lines at FOH or Monitor World. Either can be provided.

Do you have guest ether-con lines to FOH? Typically, at least 2 redundant guest ether-con lines will be available at FOH.

Are you a DJ? No.

Do you know what all the buttons and knobs do? Yes
